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Living Faith

What Is Living Faith?



Living faith is not merely believing that God exists. It is **trusting God as a present Father** — and allowing that trust to shape the way we think, choose, love, work, forgive, and endure.

Jesus did not escape the normal burdens of mortal existence. He experienced **family responsibility, misunderstanding, labor, grief, social pressure, rejection**, and the limitations of material life — yet through all of these, he maintained unbroken confidence in the Father.

Daily labor and decisions are opportunities to bring the Father into every part of life.

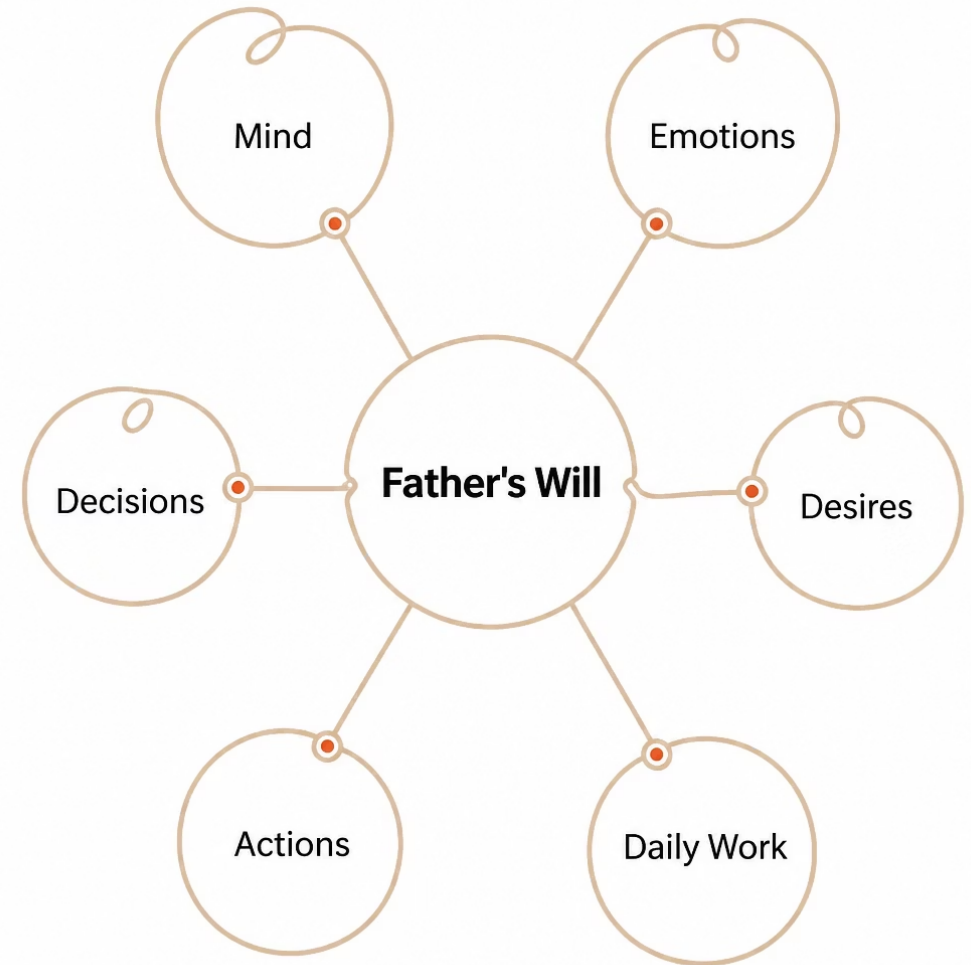
The Waiting Season

A Unified Life

One of the most powerful things about Jesus' faith is that it **unified his personality**. His mind, emotions, decisions, desires, and actions were increasingly organized around one great purpose: **doing the Father's will**.

He was not divided between spiritual ideals and material responsibilities. He brought the Father into *every part* of life.





HOW FAITH CHANGES US

God Is a Father, Not a Distant Ruler

When this becomes real in the heart, faith stops being fear-based. It becomes **personal. It becomes intimate. It becomes courageous.**

God is not waiting to punish failure — He desires relationship, trust, growth, and cooperation.

Faith That Does Not Soften the Heart Is Incomplete

→ If God is truly my Father...

Every human being is part of the wider spiritual family of God.

→ Faith must become...

Love, patience, forgiveness, service, and brotherhood — not private comfort alone.

→ A faith that does not improve how we treat people...

Is still immature. A faith that does not help us choose truth, beauty, and goodness has not yet become fully alive.

Active Cooperation With God



Living faith is not passive. It is **the human will saying yes to the divine will**, again and again, in small daily decisions.

When pride wants to win.

Choose patience

When life is delayed.
