

Jesus Parallels with Machiventa Melchizedek

- 1) Both came to Urantia in the form of a man
- 2) Neither of them married or had any children
- 3) They each dwelt near and had a major impact on Jerusalem
- 4) Both of them were here to address/fix major problems of spiritual significance
- 5) Each of them spoke several different languages
- 6) Both of them had minds that were divine and human
- 7) They each had the same thought adjuster (**only time ever**)
- 8) Only six times prior in the entire history of Nebadon,
had a Melchizedek personalized as a man of the realm.
The six bestowals of Michael had been completed prior
to his coming to Urantia to live as a man of the realm.
- 9) Both were teachers who subordinated everything to the idea/concept
of one universe deity, heavenly creator, and divine loving Father
- 10) Both stuck strictly to the fulfillment of the bestowal mission
(no reforms of mores, changes of habit, sanitary practices, or scientific truths)
- 11) They offered people the substitute sacrament of bread and wine(**flesh/blood**)
- 12) Their teachings were contaminated by older evolutionary beliefs
- 13) Both lives ended with approval of Father in heaven and Father Melchizedek
- 14) Both of them may make possible returns jointly or separate
- 15) Abraham showed cowardice 3 times on separate occasions
Peter the apostle showed cowardice 3 times on one occasion
- 16) Abraham saw and spoke to three angels in the desert
3 Apostles saw 2 angels talking with Jesus (**158:1.8**)
