The Urantia Book introduces **God the Supreme**, the evolving experiential Deity of time and space.

This leads to a deeper idea: **Cosmic morality** - morality connected to the growth of the universe.

Urantia Teaching

Urantia Book 117:4.8

"The temporal relation of man to the Supreme is the foundation for cosmic morality."

This means our moral awareness is connected to the **evolving reality of the Supreme.**

our choices affect
the universe

our character
contributes to
cosmic experience

our actions
participate in the
growth of the
Supreme.

service instead of selfishness



courage instead of fear
