

Vortexes, speculated

Sacred Power Points on Earth

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An Energy Vortex is believed to be a strong electromagnetic mass of energy that is constantly in a flux, rotating inwards in an anticlockwise or clockwise motion. This energy vortex is invisible to the naked eye (unless the person is a clairvoyant), but most people can sense these energies in the form of positive or negative vibes, feelings, emotions or mere tingling sensations.

An energy vortex can either be positively or negatively charged. Being an extremely strong energy force, it affects the nearby environment depending on its charge and the kind of energy that it constantly keeps releasing. The amount of energy being released from a single energy vortex is more powerful than any of the earth energies combined, be it in the form of Geopathic Stress Lines, Hartmann Lines, Curry Lines, Ley Lines or Black Lines.

An Energy Vortex not only keeps emitting constant negatively/positively charged energies, but it also acts as a portal for negative/positive, energies/energy forms to flow/pass through. A person may get strongly affected at a physical, mental or an intellectual level without even realizing that the effect is caused due to an energy vortex.

Vortexes are areas of high energy concentrations, originating from magnetic, spiritual, or sometimes unknown sources. Additionally they are considered to be gateways or portals to other realms, both spiritual and dimensional. Vortexes typically exist where there are strong concentrations of gravitational anomalies, in turn creating an environment that can defy gravity, bend light, scare animals, twist plant life into contorted shapes, and cause humans to feel strange. Many vortexes have been shown to be associated with Ley Lines and have been found to be extremely strong at node points where the lines cross. Worldwide, the Great Pyramid in Egypt and Stonehenge in England are perhaps the most well known as centers of vortex activity, lesser known the Gog and Magog Hills.

Besides the worldwide sites mentioned above there are quite powerful vortexes in the United States. The most notable being the Oregon Vortex, Mount Shasta Vortex, and the four Sedona, Arizona vortexes. Superstition Mountain, Arizona is also the home of vortexes. However, unlike the previous three which are more or less permanent, easily sought out and experienced by crowds of tourists, lay persons, and New Agers, the vortexes in the Superstition Mountains, although equally as powerful or maybe even more so, are much more mysterious, subtle, and depend on the coming together of certain, but not always known to all, conditions. Also considered by some as vortex hot

spots, and coincidentally, all in Arizona for some reason, are certain areas of the Grand Canyon, Sunset Crater, and the 50,000 year old meteorite impact site known as Meteor Crater.

Vortexes are labeled according to the direction of their energy flow. Up-flow Vortexes, where energy is flowing upward out of the earth; and Inflow Vortexes, where energy is flowing inward, toward the earth.

Up-flow Vortexes are said to boost spiritual skills associated with going to a higher level. They are said to stretch or expand consciousness, like filling a balloon with air. Places labeled as a magnetic vortex are areas of inflow energy. An area labeled an electric vortex is an area of up-flow energy.

Sometimes vortexes are referred to as 'positive' or 'negative.' The terms are intended to be used more in a yin/yang fashion, meaning neither good nor bad, just being opposite. However, there are those that feel there actually are 'negative vortexes' in the sense of meaning bad or evil. Such a conception is not true. It is thought the misconception originated when Up-flow Vortexes were labeled 'positive' because of the tremendous exhilaration they generated.

While an experience at an Up-flow Vortex is exhilarating, an inflow area generates a much more pensive feeling. Because the power of the vortex is flowing down rather than up, the energy at an inflow site feels heavier. On a spiritual quest or during introspective exploration, if not prepared, the first things people experience is fear. As a result inflow areas are often thought of as negative or evil.

BLACK AND WHITE SPIRALS

David Cowan, renowned Ley Line and vortex researcher, believes that energy spirals are either positive or negative earth energies. These can be the direct result of underground streams and rivers that generate energy waves vertically toward the surface. Others radiate horizontally.

These vortex energies are known as black spirals or white spirals. The malevolent energy is found in black spirals and benevolent energy is found in white spirals. Paranormal activity can often be attributed to a black spiral or vortex. It has been theorized that these natural occurring energies are responsible for such phenomena as crop circles.

Mineral deposits in the earth are believed to create or augment energy vortexes. Quartz is known to generate energy and geological areas high in quartz are believed to serve as a conduit for various energies, especially psychic and spiritual.

MOUNT SHASTA, CALIFORNIA

Mt. Shasta is located at the southern end of the Cascade Range, which runs like a dragon from northern California, through Oregon, and through Washington to the Canadian border. There are many powerful mountains in this range, with Mt. Shasta and Mount Rainier – overlooking Seattle – the best known.



Shasta is the most primal of the earth chakras. It is at the “base” of the world energy system. Here, the raw precursors of biological life are released into global circulation and development. Mt. Shasta regulates the universal life force prior to its integration into individual life

forms and species. The energy of Shasta, as the first chakra, is like a geyser – a great uprush of life energy, or prana, without shape or structure.

Mount Shasta, in Northern California, is the second highest peak in the Cascades and the fifth highest in California. This potentially active volcano which last erupted in 1786, is considered a holy mountain by the Native Americans and thought to be one of the first earthly places created by Great Spirit. Poet Joaquin Miller describes it, 'Lonely as God, and white as a winter moon'.

THE GRAND CANYON, ARIZONA

The Grand Canyon in Arizona, was carved by the Colorado River possibly more than 17 million years ago, although of course the river continues to carve it even deeper. It is 277 miles long, up to 18 miles wide and in places reaches a mile in depth. The steep walls reveal nearly



2 billion years of the Earth's geological history. Not surprising that this site is also considered holy, sacred and a place for pilgrimage.

SEDONA, ARIZONA

Sedona is also in Arizona about 100 miles south of the Grand Canyon, surrounded by 1.8 million acres of national forest and extraordinary red sandstone rock. It is considered to be The Most Beautiful Place on the Planet. With a wealth of outdoor activities as well as alternative therapies of every persuasion, Sedona is a magnet for tourists and seekers alike.



LAKE TITICACA, BOLIVIA & PERU

Lake Titicaca is located on the Island of the Sun where the Titicaca Stone is found. The lake itself is located in the high plateau of Collao in the Southern highlands of Peru, on the border with Bolivia.



These territories were inhabited by cultures before the Incas, especially by the Tiahuanaco (100 - 700 AD), later, when this kingdom was destroyed, its people went to the North and then, its descendants founded the Inca kingdom. Finally, the Incas conquered these territories and considered the lake as a sacred place.

Lake Titicaca is the place the god Viracocha came out of to make the sun, the stars and the first people. It is the largest lake in South America at 120 miles long and 50 miles at its widest and is situated between Peru and Bolivia. It is also the highest navigable body of water in the world. According to Incan mythology their first king, Manco Capac, was born there.

MACHU PICCHU, PERU

Machu Picchu perched almost 8000 feet above sea level is an enigmatic spot.



According to current mainstream history it is The Lost City of the Incas built in the 15th century. The feat to build this city at such altitude defies logic. Situated not far from Cusco with the Urubamba river snaking below, its eyrie like position offers unrivalled views across the Andean landscape.

ULURU, AUSTRALIA

Two massive rock structures in central Australia, Uluru (Ayers Rock) and Kata Tjuta (The Olgas), in Australia's Northern Territory, are said to represent the emotional solar plexus, considered the "umbilical cord" supplying energy to all living things. Uluru, formerly known as Ayers Rock, is the more famous of the two. This large red monolith is, along with the Sydney Opera House, an icon of the smallest continent. Kata Tjuta, also called The Olgas, is equally impressive. Rather than one monolith, this site consists of a large number of massive red stones. The global function of this chakra is to maintain the vitality of the Earth, and all living species.

Uluru, a huge sandstone rock 2.2 miles long by 1.2 miles wide, stands 1141 feet proud of the surrounding flat landscape. Now known by its original Aboriginal name, Uluru conveys far more of its powerful presence than when it was called Ayers Rock. This is the spiritual heart of Australia, a beacon towering over the land with awe-inspiring and ancient rock paintings.



Uluru or Ayers Rock, in Uluru-Kata Tjuta National Park in Australia's Northern Territory, has beguiled people for centuries and is a sacred spot for Anangu people, with theories that it was formed by ancestral beings who shaped the world. Science suggests the sandstone monolith began forming around 550 million years ago, and centuries of erosion and folding crafted its distinctive oval shape. Its red surface is due to oxidation, while "fresh" rock beneath is gray.

KATA TJUTA, AUSTRALIA

Kata Tjuta is a series of 38 sacred rock domes situated 16 miles from Uluru in the same National Park. Together they form part of the traditional belief system of one of the oldest human societies on the planet and are considered to be 500 million years old.



GLASTONBURY & SHAFTESBURY, ENGLAND

Glastonbury, Somerset and Shaftesbury, Dorset define the center for the force of greater life. To be directed to maximum effect, the Grail of Immortality must be permeated by the Wand of the True Will. Glastonbury is the home of the Holy Grail; and Shaftesbury is the high place of the Sacred Spear of Purpose. When the earth energies of Glastonbury unite with those of Shaftesbury, then the Rainbow Serpent ley artery is able to deliver the immortalizing frequencies of the Holy Grail to all beings worldwide.

Glastonbury, a small market town in Somerset, is dominated by its famous tor, on top of which stands the roofless St Michaels Tower. Hosting one of the most well-known musical festivals each year Glastonbury is also known for its spirituality and as a New Age Center. The tor itself is home to Gwyn Ap Nudd, King of the Fairies. It also lays claim to being the Avalon of King Arthur.



Shaftesbury in Dorset, is an ancient hill top town with its iconic cobbled road plunging down the steep and beautiful Golden Hill. It was founded in 880 by Alfred the Great, and King Canute's heart was buried there. It is a powerful point on the planet with its profound connection to Glastonbury.



THE GANGES RIVER, INDIA

The Ganges River begins life at the Gangotri Glacier in India and travels 1500 miles to pour its heart out to sea at the Ganges Delta in the Bay of Bengal. Named after the Hindu Goddess Ganga and regarded as the heart of Indian culture, tradition and living, she is also revered as a mother and a

goddess. According to mythology the Ganges descended to Earth to make the land pious and fertile as well as to wash away the sins of humanity.

THE GREAT PYRAMID OF GIZA, EGYPT

The Great Pyramid of Giza and Mount Sinai in Egypt are said to be the Voice of our planet, governing our communication of thoughts and feelings. It is how we express our inner creativity. The Great Pyramid of Giza, also called the Pyramid of Khufu and the Pyramid of Cheops, is the oldest and largest of the three pyramids in the Giza Necropolis.



Originally, the Great Pyramid was covered by casing stones that formed a smooth outer surface; what is seen today is the underlying core structure. Some of the casing stones that once covered the structure can still be seen around the base. At its heart are two rooms known as the King's Chamber and the Queen's Chamber.

The Great Pyramid of Giza still keeps its secrets close to its heart as no-one, even with our current technological brilliance can work out how it was built, with its precise alignment to the four directions and the precision of each rock. It is made out of almost 2 and 1/2 million limestone blocks which weigh 2 and a 1/2 tons apiece. Mainstream Egyptology tells us it was built by Khufu 2 and 1/2 thousand years BC but there is much work to show it could have been built 10,000 years ago. The jury is out.

MOUNT SINAI, EGYPT

Mount Sinai, found on the Sinai Peninsula, is the possible mountain where Moses was given



the 10 commandments by God, although there is no archeological confirmation of this. If it is the place then it is also where the Arc of the Covenant came into being, the site of the Burning Bush, and many other Biblical occurrences. The climb to its 7500-foot peak is well worth the effort as the view is astonishing.

MOUNT OF OLIVES, JERUSALEM, ISRAEL



Mount of Olives, a 2600 foot peak set on a ridge on the east of Jerusalem was once covered in olive groves. King David fled over it to escape his rebellious son, King Solomon. He built pagan temples there after he turned away from God and Jesus went there to rest and pray.

MOUNT FUJI, JAPAN

Mount Fuji, the highest mountain in Japan rises over 12,000 feet above Honshu Island, just over 60 miles from Tokyo. An active volcano it last erupted in 1707, although apparently it is under a lot of pressure due to the 2011 earthquake not far away. It is the holiest of Japan's 'Three Holy Mountains', is named for the Buddhist fire goddess Fuchi, and the shrine on the summit is sacred to the Shinto goddess Sengen-Sama.



KAILASH, TIBET

Mount Kailash is believed to enable our connection to our Higher Power — a gateway to the Divine. Located high in the mountains of Tibet, Mount Kailash is at the “crown” of Earth — in a perfect position to communicate with the entire Universe and all its inhabitants. Kailash is the most sacred mountain in the Himalayas, and is located in Tibet rising to 22,028 feet in one of the highest and most rugged parts of the Himalayas.



Mount Kailash is considered the home of Shiva. It is close by two sacred lakes and the sources of four major rivers. It's south face has a distinctive gash across it which looks like a swastika, but in that part of the world it is symbolic of good luck. According to the mythology if you walk as a pilgrim to Mount Kailash your sins will be washed away.

STONEHENGE, ENGLAND



Stonehenge is a prehistoric monument in Wiltshire, England, 2 miles west of Amesbury. It consists of a ring of standing stones, with each standing stone around 13 feet high, 7 feet wide and weighing around 25 tons. The stones are set within earthworks in the middle of the densest complex of Neolithic and Bronze Age monuments in England,

including several hundred burial mounds. During the twentieth century, Stonehenge began to revive as a place of religious significance, this time by adherents of Neopaganism and New Age beliefs, particularly the Neo-druids. Many of the megalithic stone structures are situated at places with measurable geophysical anomalies (the so-called earth energies) such as localized magnetism, geothermal activity, specific minerals, and the presence of underground water. While there is nothing paranormal about these forces, what is fascinating is that ancient people located the specific sites where these energies were present. For reasons still not fully understood, these energies seem to fluctuate in radiant intensity according to the cyclic influences of different celestial bodies (primarily the sun and moon but also the planets and stars). The architectural configurations of the megalithic structures were designed to determine those particular periods of increased energetic potency at the sites. Those periods were then used by people for a variety of healing, spiritual and oracular purposes.

EASTER ISLAND

This pacific Island holds 887 carved humanlike statues that were recently discovered to be nearly twice the size as the portion exposed above ground. Easter Island is commonly believed to be within a large black spiral. The island was formed by volcanic activity and is in keeping with the vile vortex pattern that crosses the planet. Easter Island is a Chilean island in the southeastern Pacific Ocean, at the southeasternmost point of the Polynesian Triangle in Oceania. Easter Island is most famous for its nearly



1,000 extant monumental statues, called “moai”, created by the early Rapa Nui people. In 1995, UNESCO named Easter Island a World Heritage Site, with much of the island protected within Rapa Nui National Park.

It was the Rapa Nui people who crafted and erected the 1,000-odd stone giants known as moai, around 900 years ago. But no one really knows how they managed to move the 40-foot-tall

statues, which weigh around 14 tons each, into place – or why they exist at all. A prevalent theory is that the ancient Polynesians walked them from quarries using stone platforms and placed them to mark freshwater sources. The statues' bodies are buried to leave only the curious heads exposed.

THE BERMUDA TRIANGLE

The Bermuda Triangle, also known as the Devil's Triangle, is a loosely-defined region in the western part of the North Atlantic Ocean, where a number of aircraft and ships are said to have disappeared under mysterious circumstances. Most reputable sources dismiss the idea that



there is any mystery. The vicinity of the Bermuda Triangle is amongst the most heavily traveled shipping lanes in the world, with ships frequently crossing through it for ports in the Americas, Europe and the Caribbean islands. Popular culture has attributed various disappearances to the paranormal or activity by extraterrestrial beings. Documented evidence indicates that a significant percentage of the incidents were spurious, inaccurately reported, or embellished by later authors.

The most well-known energy vortex is the Bermuda Triangle where countless ships and planes have disappeared without a trace. The most famous of these is Flight 19, a five-plane training squad that set out from Fort Lauderdale, Florida in 1945 for a routine training mission. The crew radioed it was having equipment malfunctions and they were unable to distinguish between the sky and ocean. No trace was ever found of the planes and pilots. This is just one of such mysterious disappearances recorded over the past 500 years within the Bermuda Triangle.

As synonymous with mystery as Venice is with canals, the Bermuda Triangle – covering around 500,000 square miles between Bermuda, Miami in Florida and San Juan in Puerto Rico – has seen more than 20 planes and 50 ships crash with no obvious explanation and even some “vanish” completely. Theories range from suggestions of supernatural activity to the more logical hypotheses that it is due to magnetic compass variation or rogue waves.

Where is the Bermuda Triangle?

The Bermuda Triangle, according to the Encyclopedia Britannica, is an area of the Atlantic Ocean that doesn't necessarily have an agreed-upon boundary, but it is generally considered to be the area bounded by the southeastern coast of the U.S., Bermuda, and the islands of Cuba, Hispaniola, Jamaica, and, Puerto Rico. According to some calculations, the area makes up anywhere between 500,000 and 1.5 million square miles and is triangle-like in shape. It's a pretty big area of ocean in general, though relatively small considering the ocean covers about 70 percent of the planet, or about 139.7 million square miles.

According to Encyclopedia Britannica, there's no telling how many ships or planes that have "disappeared" in the Bermuda Triangle, but some estimates guess around 50 ships and 20 aircraft have gone missing there. Despite these figures, data does not show that disappearances are more likely in this spot. There are two incidents that are considered mysteries of the Bermuda Triangle, specifically the disappearances of Flight 19 in 1945 and the USS Collier in 1918. There is no clear indication that these disappearances have anything to do with the supernatural, but they are still unexplained.

Have people gone missing in the Bermuda Triangle?

Conspiracy theorists have proposed many different, though mostly superstitious and inconceivable, reasons as to why disappearances and disasters occur in the Bermuda Triangle. Some have theorized that the area is a hotbed of alien activity, positing that these extraterrestrial beings are abducting humans for study, according to the New York Post. Alien theorists have considered this spot to be a sort of maritime Area 51. Others have suggested that it is the real-life locations of the lost continent of Atlantis, therefore making it a portal to another dimension, according to History.com.

The most likely culprit for these mysteries is not really a mystery at all. According to the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), most scientific explanations include the many tropical storms and hurricanes which pass through this area and the Gulf Stream Current, which can cause sudden and extreme changes in the weather. There may even be some evidence that suggests that this area has a particular geomagnetic anomaly that can cause a ship or plane's navigation to point to "true" north rather than "magnetic" north. This can lead to navigation failure, though it should be noted that magnetic fields are found all over the world and are not exclusive to this area. Other theories also include explosive methane gas that can float up to the water's surface and cause ships to sink, according to Live Science, and simple, human error. In the case of Flight 19, according to Live Science, it is most likely that the squadron of bombers ran out of fuel and crashed into the ocean. It is a tragic disaster, but it may not be a true mystery.

The superstitions and stories still prevail, mostly because this area is perceived to have more disappearances or tragic accidents than other parts of the world. However, this is actually untrue. According to the Huffington Post, the World Wildlife Fund found the most dangerous waters on the planet, but the Bermuda Triangle is not one of them. In fact, it is not even mentioned in the report.

According to Live Science, a third of all of all registered and privately owned ships in the U.S. are registered in the area considered to be part of the Bermuda Triangle, and about 82 percent of incidents in 2016 were due to people having little experience at sea. Inexperienced people using road maps or their smartphones to navigate, rather than specialized equipment, may also be contributing to the so-called mystery.

Considering the superstition surrounding the Bermuda Triangle, many people assume that airline pilots actively avoid this area of the ocean. Of course, anyone who has flown from Miami to San Juan, Puerto Rico probably knows that is not true. In fact, if it were, pretty much everyone's Caribbean vacation would be ruined. A check on Flightradar24 will show that there are many flights that crisscross over the Bermuda Triangle, so it is clear that the area is not actively avoided.

In terms of navigation, flights are constantly monitored by air traffic control, so pilots have support if there is a navigation failure. Weather conditions are also closely tracked every time a plane is scheduled to take off. Accidents, of course, still happen, but not any more so than in other parts of the world.

Investigating Bermuda Triangle conspiracy theories, in general, is more of a paranormal pursuit than a scientific one, so if there are any pilots who do avoid the Bermuda Triangle, they are probably just interested in the supernatural or UFOs.

POLAR VORTEXES IN THE NORTH AND SOUTH POLES
