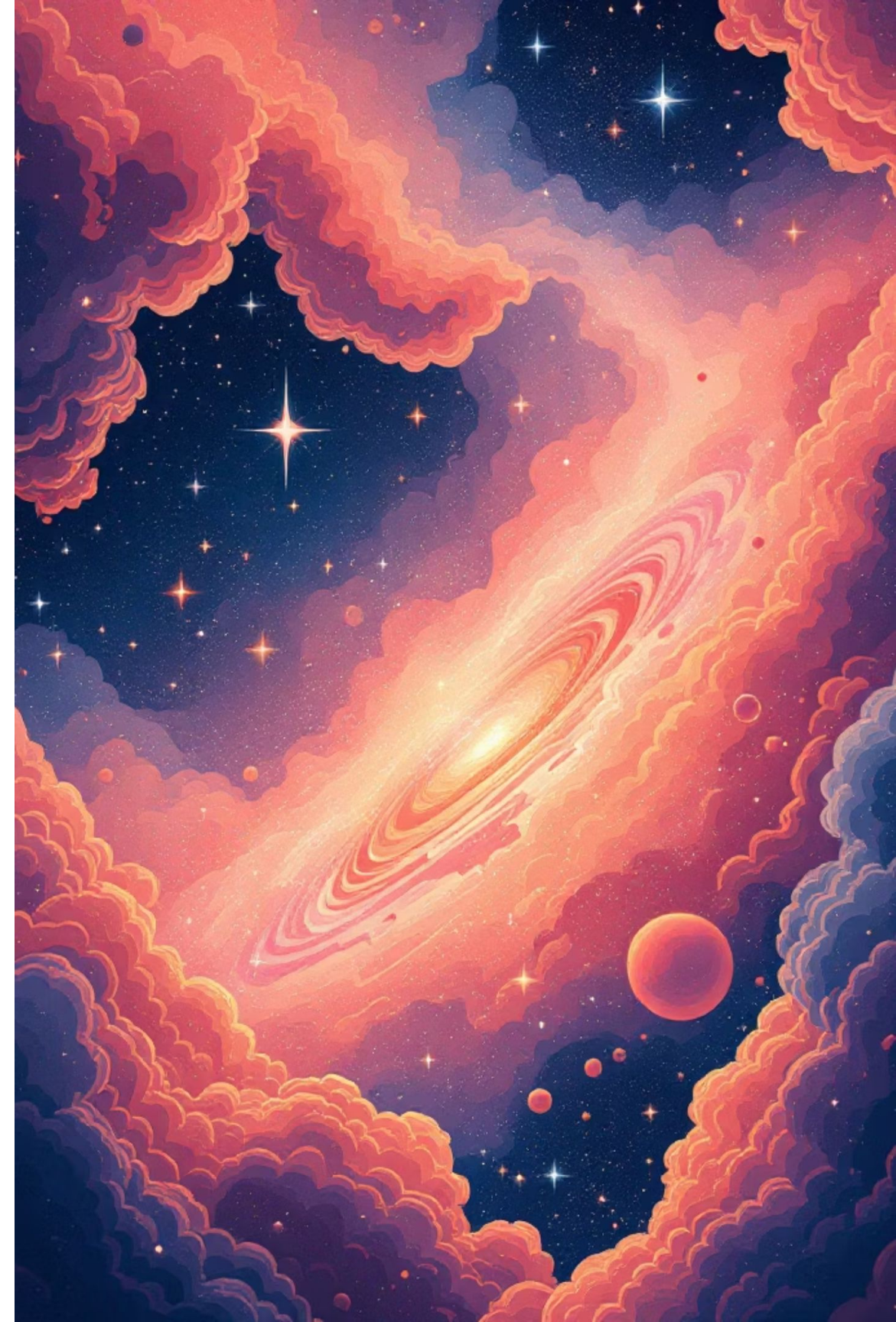


What if the universe is still unfolding?

Eternal

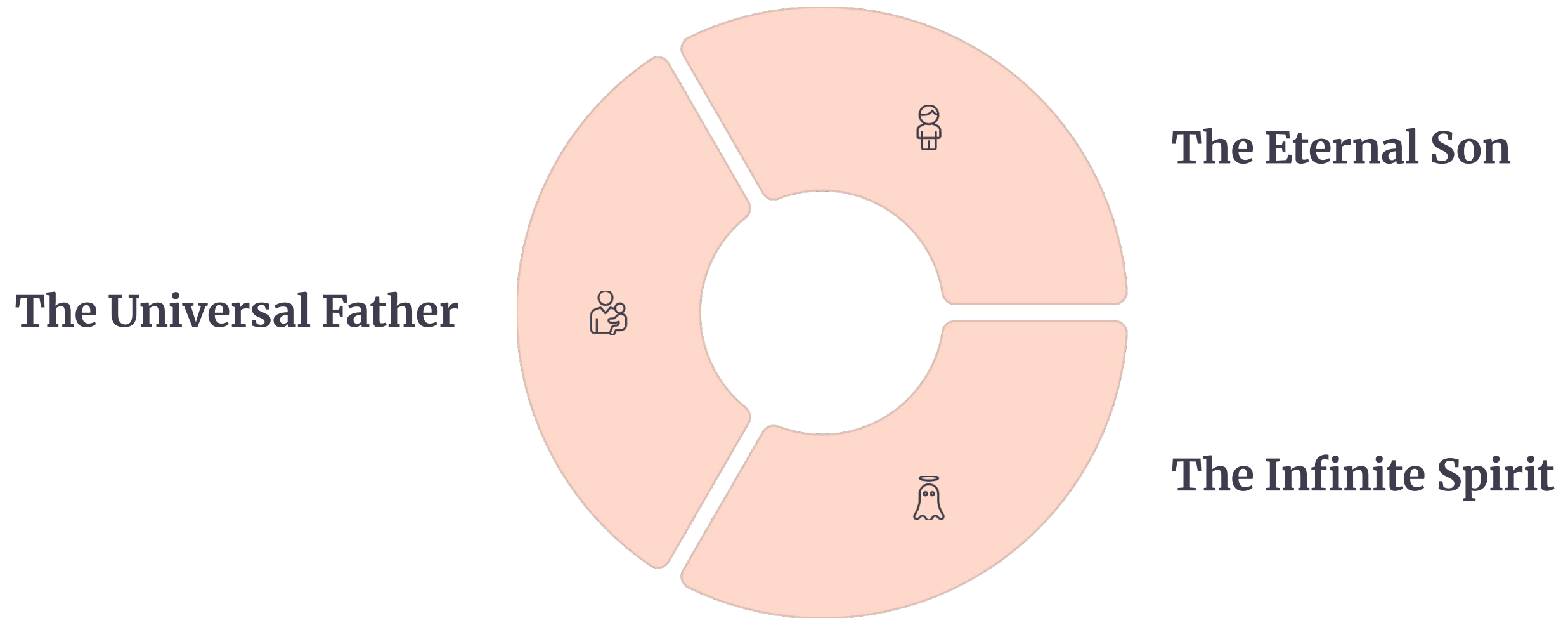
Perfect

The Paradise Trinity

The Urantia teachings describe the eternal God as the **Paradise Trinity**:



These three divine persons exist eternally and form the **timeless foundation of the universe**.

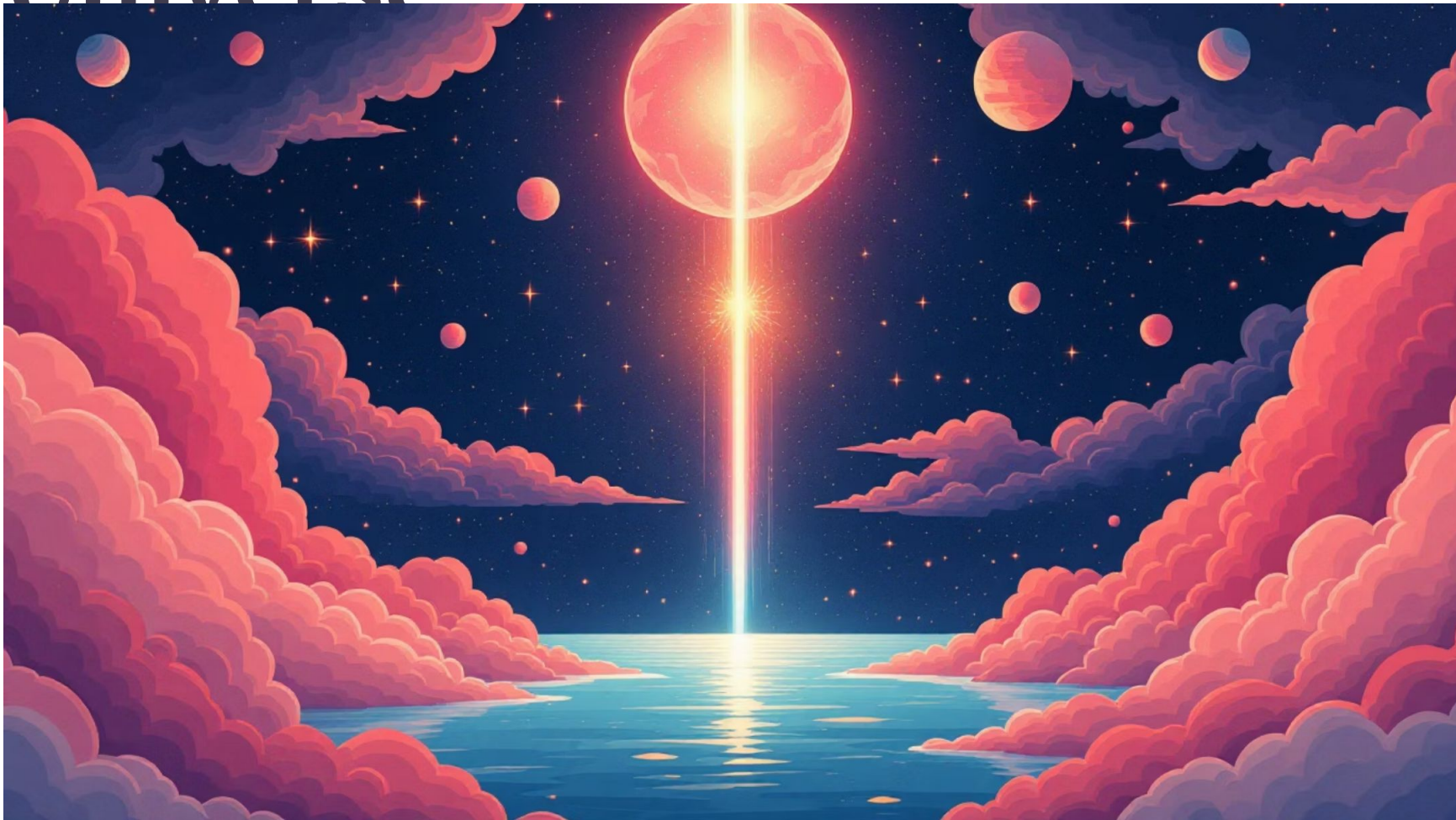


The Experiential Aspect of Deity

The Urantia Book describes an experiential dimension of God called **God the Supreme**—a Deity developing through the experiences of creation.
